

New To Medicare Checklist

- Three months prior to your 65th birthday, apply for Medicare Part B.
Call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213 or visit your local Social Security Office. Use this link to locate your local office. www.socialsecurity.gov/locator/
- Three months before your 65th birthday, Mail, Fax or Email a list of the prescriptions you are currently taking to partd@southernSeniorcare.com . We will enter your exact prescriptions into Medicare's Part D selection tool and email you the results within one business day.
- Get a copy of "2008 Choosing a Medigap Policy." You can call 800-351-6898 or email: sales@southernSeniorcare.com and request a FREE copy. You can also download an Adobe PDF copy at www.southernSeniorcare.com/resources
- Within six (6) months of the "Part B" date on your Medicare card, you need to select a Medicare Supplement Plan. Most people do this the same time as their Medicare Part B. This is your "Open Enrollment Period." Do not miss it.
- If you are interested in Long Term Care, now is the time. Every birthday you have from now on will result in significant premium increases. Also, if you experience any major illness, you may not be able to get Long Term Care.
